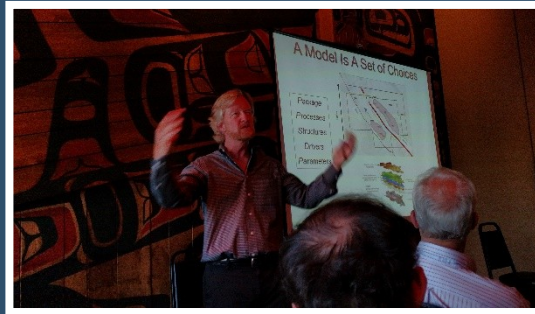
AWRA-WA MISSION

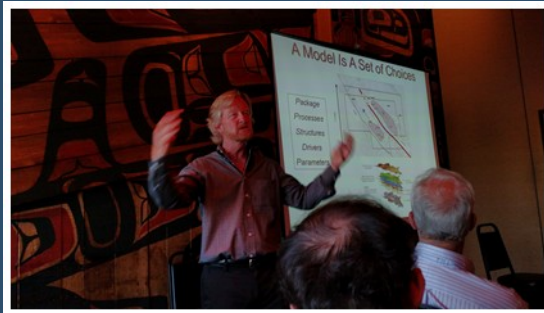


- Two \$2,500 student fellowships
